#### **CULTURE**



## **UNDER 19 FOOTBALL**

The club is delighted to welcome Chris Smith as the Blacks Under 19s coach for 2018. Chris played senior footy with Swan Hill FC and Woomelang FC, then coached extensively in junior football and rep level basketball. In 2017 Chris coached the Swan Hill FC Colts to a premiership and was also a selector for the Swan Hill FC senior side.

The U19s is an excellent pathway to senior football where outstanding footballers have the opportunity to display their skill at a senior level. We foster young talent through the University Blacks Academy, which develops both football and professional/career skills through professional mentorship and individualised training programs. Our players come from near and far but quickly form a tight unit, helped along by many social activities.
